Project Name : Kolkata Environmental Improvement Investment Program (KEIIP) – Project 1.

Kolkata Municipal Corporation through Government of West Bengal (GoWB) and Government of India (GoI) (Borrower) has received a loan amounting to USD 100 Million from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) towards the cost of Kolkata Environmental Improvement Investment Program (KEIIP), Project-1, Tranche-1. The project aims at improved access to water supply and sanitation in selected areas of Kolkata Municipal Corporation (KMC). Infrastructure Works under the project comprises of 2 (two) components viz. (i) rehabilitation of inefficient water supply assets and (ii) extension of sewerage and drainage to peripheral areas. Tranche-2 and Tranche-3 of the Program are expected to be processed by ADB in 2015-16 and 2017-18 respectively subject to progress achieved in Project-1 which ends in December 2018.
2. KMC represented by the Project Director, KEIIP now invites sealed Proposals/Bids from eligible bidders for Third Party Inspection (TPI) Services for KEIIP, Project-1. Details of the services are provided in Terms of Reference.
